The following changes were proposed and approved:

- a) The nomenclature of Programme B.Sc. (Fashion Technology) was proposed to be changed to B.Sc. (Fashion Design) as the syllabus is design based which is the need of the market and employability.
- b) It was recommended that students of Department of Fashion & Textile Technology can also opt for Generic Electives offered by the Department.
- c) It was suggested by the experts that Textiles may be offered as one of the Elective Courses in the B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. instead of - B.Sc. Textiles programmes as there are hardly any takers for this programme for the last two years. It was further proposed that the curriculum should be designed keeping in mind the employability of the students.
- d) Further, it was proposed that M.A. /M. Sc./M.Com. Textiles should be discontinued as there are no takers for the programme. When the Textiles subject becomes a popular subject and there are sufficient numbers of students interested in a Master's



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Course in Textiles, the Department could offer post graduate programme at that stage.

- 3. The BOS co-opted Ms.Isheeta Chaturvedi for Garment Production & Export Management, Textiles and Career Oriented & Skill Development Course and Ms. Lakshmi Agarwal for Fashion Technology and as a Member of BOS Examiners Selection Committee for the Academic session 2016-17.
- 4. The Question Papers of Semester-I, III, V Examinations November 2015 and Semesters II, IV and VI Examination April 2015 were reviewed and suggestions given by the BOS members were duly noted.
- 5. The Examiners Reports for the Semester –I, III, V Examinations November 2015 and Semesters II, IV and VI Examinations April 2015 examinations were reviewed.
- 6. The model question papers of semester I-VI, based on revised and approved syllabi were considered and approved.
- 7. The syllabus for the Ph.D. coursework as part of the Ph.D. programme in Fashion & Textile Technology for the session 2016-17 was considered and approved.
