The following suggestions were made for incorporation into the syllabi:

I. Elective Hindi Course:

(i) **CHIN 101** : In the Core Course (Hindi Sahitya ka Itihas) of Semester I,

a) Chhayavad, Pragtivad, Prayogvad, Nayi Kavita should be added in the Unit IV, so that students can get full knowledge of Hindi Literature, since the syllabus of UGC is confined up to Dwivedi Yug.

b) General introduction of 'Gaddhya-Vidha' other than Upanyas, Kahani, Natak, Nibandh should be added in the Unit V of the same syllabus.

(ii) **CHIN 201**: In the core course of Semester II (Madhyakalin Hindi Kavita), 'Madhyakalin Hindi Kavita' students should get introduction of 'Premashrayii Kaavya Dhara' along with 'Sant Kaavya Dhara'. Since Jayasi is the representative poet of Premashrayii Kaavya Dhara, hence 'Jayasi ka Vyaktitv Evam Krativ' may be included in Unit I.

(iii) **CHIN 301**: In the core course of Semester III (Aadhunik Hindi Kavita), introduction of modern writers should be given. Hence Kedarnath Agarwal should be introduced in Unit V.

(iv) **CHIN 401**: In the core course of Semester IV (Hindi Gadhya Sahitya),

(a) In Unit I, novel 'Tyag Patra' Jenendra Kumar can be replaced with 'Aap ka Bunty' by Manu Bhandari.

(b) In the Unit II Premchand's 'Namak ka Daroga' can be replaced with his other story 'Poos Ki Raat'.

(c) It was also suggested that Jai Shankar Prasad's 'Aakashdeep' should be replaced with his another work 'Usne Kaha Tha', since it shows conflict between love and nationalism.

5. The BOS Co-opted Dr. Neha Singhi as member of the Examiners Selection Committee for the academic session 2017-18.
