climate change problems, biovalorization of green house gases and carbon dioxide sequestration in these papers.

- It was observed that the content of these two papers (BTE 601 and MBL 601) was similar and hence, the experts approved to merge them and form a common paper of BTE/MBL 601.
- MBL 202: Unit I of the paper was too vast and included role of microbes in many fields of microbiology. Moreover, many of these topics are covered in the papers offered in other semesters. Thus the committee approved to reduce the content and to retain only some of the specific areas of microbiology.
- BTE/MBL 224: the syllabus was reviewed and shuffling of contents of the paper was suggested and approved in order to increase the coherence.
- BTE 425: the members recommended to redistribute 20 hrs allocated for unit I in to other units.
- BTE 426: practical list was revised and practical's based on nanoparticle synthesis were incorporated.
- The practical list of all papers was revised and new practical's were added to existing list. For example practical of nanoparticle synthesis was incorporated in BTE 426; evaluation of disinfectants and antiseptics in MBL 326; Surface Sterilization of pant parts in BTE 503
   etc.
- The syllabus of Generic elective paper (GIPR 401) in Intellectual Property Rights was revised and restructured with respect to content and working hours.
- Syllabi of two new papers i.e., Intellectual Property Rights (LSC 144 L) and Nanotechnology (LSC 144 M) for course work examination of PhD in life sciences were proposed and approved with minor changes.
