- Inclusion of African and Canadian Literature as well as Cultural theories
 With this session onwards, the current batch of first year students will be exposed to more of the above mentioned, especially at the PG level wherein new writers and texts have been introduced in Sem. III.
 Cultural theories, however, form part of Culture Studies which, at the moment, is not offered in the Department as a separate course. However, it will be proposed in the next BOS
