
















AASHIRWAAD-2016 FAREWELL CEREMONY

One-week Student Interaction Programme (29 July-4 August '15)

Report

The inception of the student-interaction programme took place when a group of nine undergraduate students from PSU arrived at The IIS University, as part of the partnership between the two universities for academic interchange of ideas. The welcome included with the traditional *tika-moli*, after which the American students were greeted by the sixteen members of the Core Student Group the hosting university. This was followed by an interface with a few faculty members and the management. The Vice-Chancellor, Dr. Ashok Gupta, addressed the gathering by formally welcoming the visiting students. The students were also accorded a floral welcome by Rector and Registrar, Dr. Raakhi Gupta. The group escort with the American students, Ms. Sakshi Bhargava, a Doctoral student at Penn. State, thanked The IIS University for hosting them.

The next couple of days saw both student-groups participating in a host of interactive activities, which included tie and dye, pottery and sculpture, jewellery-making, mehandi-applying, classical Indian dance-class, yoga and adventure activities such as rappelling. In addition, both the Indian and American students collaborated and made audio-visual presentations on a varied number of topics of mutual concern. The presentations were highly interactive and informative and the topics ranged from Religion and Spirituality, Rajasthani Music, Natural Resources to Women in Cinema and their Objectification in the Media. In another session on Research and Career Prospects in the US, the group escort – Ms. Bhargava - addressed the Indian students on how to select and apply to American universities and the prerequisites for the same.

The American students also experienced home visits, which gave them an opportunity to meet the Indian host family and get to know the culture and lifestyle over dinner. They were also taken out for shopping and local sightseeing. On the final day of the interaction, a cultural performance entitled 'East Meets West' was put up by both the groups to bid farewell to the American students, some of whom also shared their experiences. The programme co-ordinator, Dr. Rimika Singhvi, presented mementoes to the PSU group and also extended an informal vote of thanks. Thereafter, the group departed back for Delhi.
