Therefore, it is recommended that the existing syllabi should not be moderated or toned down.
- 2. These students with special needs should attend classes with the main stream students.

- 3. The examination scheme and pattern of question papers should be changed for these students to include more objective type questions and short answer type questions. The Controller of Examination, Dr. Nisha Yadav has been requested to get the blue prints of these papers prepared and approved. The Examination Cell will make arrangements to provide for a scribe each for these students for the internal as well as Semester End Examinations.
- 4. Promotion Scheme These students may be promoted from an even semester to the next higher semester if they earn 16 credits out of the 48 credits assigned to the electives in the two semesters of that academic year.
- 5. Award of Certificate /Diploma/ Degree The performance of these students may be reviewed at the end of six semesters or thereafter on the request of the candidate and they may be awarded Certificate /Diploma/Advanced Diploma or Degree on the basis of their cumulative progress, as per the proposed criterion given below:



He also said that the society is adverse to accepting disabled persons hence, The rights of persons with disabilities act, 2016 should endorse the rights of such people.

He was of view that psychological hindrances plague persons with disabilities but there are numerous ways to overcome them.

Prayas works for the education, rehabilitation and empowerment of the mentally and physically challenged (differently-able) and socially disadvantaged children. It is a non-profit, Non-Governmental Organization (NGO). It indirectly serves over 20,000 families in the community through different activities: health camps, adult education, vocational training, BAL clubs and community services. It is registered with Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Societies Registration Act, 1958, Foreign Contribution Regulation Act, 1976 (Reg. No. 125560127), National Institute of Open Schooling, Rajasthan Education Board, Rehabilitation Council of India and Indira Gandhi National Open University. The mission of Prayas is mission is the integration of children, with and without special needs, into mainstream schooling and society by providing quality education to enable their growth and development towards becoming self-sufficient individuals who can live with dignity.

The services include facilitating Inclusive Education (Education for all), enhancing skills of differently-able children and develop a positive attitude towards self-reliance, providing income generating projects that will enable differently-able needs adults to become economically self-sufficient. It also develops strategies for marketing the products made by the physically and mentally disabled so that their income can be ensured. It advocates and network with governmental and non-governmental institutes for child rights. It develops a resource centre in accordance with special needs in changing environment. It

creates awareness in the community to participate in child education and to fight for child rights.
