**PAPER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES**

**For Paper Presenters:**

1. **Presentation Format and Duration:** Each paper presentation is allocated a **maximum of 4 minutes, followed by a 2-minute discussion/Q&A**. Please adhere strictly to the time limit.
2. **Preparation:** Ensure that your presentation slides (PPT) are well-prepared, concise, and aligned with your research paper.
3. **Submission of PPT:** Kindly email your finalized presentation at [efbrconference@iisuniv.ac.in](mailto:efbrconference@iisuniv.ac.in) by 25 March 2026.
4. **File Naming Convention:** All participants must name their PowerPoint presentation using the author's/presenter's name and paper ID. *For example: Aakansha\_S4001.*
5. **Camera and Audio:** Presenters must keep their camera on during the presentation and ensure clear and audible communication.
6. **Internet Connectivity:** Ensure a stable internet connection to avoid disruptions during your presentation.
7. **Multiple Authors:** In case of multiple authors, any one author may present the paper on behalf of the group.

**General Instructions:**

1. **Early Session Joining:** All participants are requested to join the Zoom meeting link at least 15 minutes before the scheduled start time to ensure a smooth commencement of the session.
2. **Session Attendance:** Participants attending the conference without presenting are required to attend all sessions on both days of the event.
3. **Session Presence:** Presenters are expected to remain present throughout their assigned session.
4. **Digital Etiquette:** Maintain professional decorum. Keep your microphone muted when not speaking and avoid interruptions during other presentations.

**Additional Instructions:**

1. **Presentation Content:** Focus on key aspects such as objectives, methodology, major findings, and implications. Avoid excessive text on slides.
2. **Time Management:** Practice beforehand to ensure your presentation fits within the allotted time.
3. **Q&A Participation:** Be prepared to respond to questions from session chairs
