Feedback-Analysis

Action Taken

Around 80% students have found the course to be Job Oriented: Approximately 91% students found the course content to be knowledgeable and interesting; Around 80% students have found the curriculum was framed to today market demands. About 80% students felt that ample Co-Curricular activities are conducted. Nearly 74% students are satisfied with the wide of Extra-Curricular range activities conducted in University. About 75% are likely to recommend the course to others.

None needed; the feedback was, however, shared by the Departments in the respective BOS Meetings for the members' information. The constitution of the BOS includes an alumna for the purpose of formalizing the seeking and recording of such feedback.

Analysis and Action-Taken for Compliance
