The year 2019 has been declared as the International Year of Periodic Table of Chemical Elements by UNESCO, as part of commemoration of the 150th anniversary of the establishment of Mendeleev`s Periodic Table of Elements, one of the most significant and influential achievements of Science. It also coincides with the centenary of International Union of Pure and Applied Chemistry. As part of the celebration, the IISU Chemical Association announces Inter-Collegiate Competitions based on the periodic table for the Under Graduate and Post Graduate students of Science. These activities are being planned in order to promote a better and deeper understanding of scientific facts pertaining to the Periodic Table.

CREATIONS: 3D MODEL OF PERIODIC TABLE

Create your own periodic table in the form of 3D model for enhanced learning and innovation.

- **Team size** Maximum two members in a team
- **Number of entries** Maximum two teams from each institution
- **Model size** Table top size is 2 ft x 1.5 ft

The entries will be judged on the basis of concept and creativity, presentation, neatness and use of ecofriendly material.



POSTER COMPETITION

- **Topic** Create your own Periodic Table
- **Team size** Maximum two members in a team
- **Number of entries** Maximum two teams from each institution
- **Poster size** 2 ft x 3 ft

The entries will be judged on the basis of concept and creativity, presentation and content.

Participants will bring their prepared poster on the topic provided. The posters will be displayed and evaluated as per the schedule, which will be announced later.



JAM (Just a minute)

- **Topic** Influence of elements in our daily life/ Tales from the periodic table
- **Team size** One member
- **Time duration** 1 minute (with 1 minute preparation)
- **Number of entries** Maximum two teams from each institution

The entries will be judged on the basis of gestures, presentation, content and approach to the topic.



QUIZ

- **Team size** Group of three
- **Number of entries** Maximum two teams from each institution

In case number of entries is more then there will be elimination round.

The specific rules regarding evaluation procedure, time limit and type of rounds will be given on the spot.



SKIT

- **Topic** Know Your Elements
- **Team size** Minimum 5 and maximum 8 participants.
- **Number of entries** Maximum two teams from each institution
- **Time duration** 8-10 minutes
- No props will be provided by the organisers.
- Language no bar. Explicit, abusive or vulgar content will not be allowed.

The Skit will be judged on the basis of the quality of the content, theme, work on acting and presentation.
