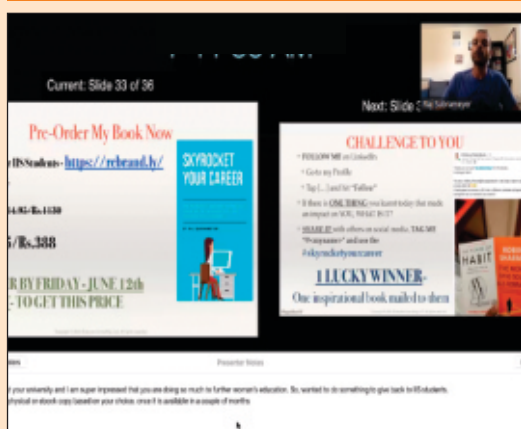

How to find your dream job under any circumstances



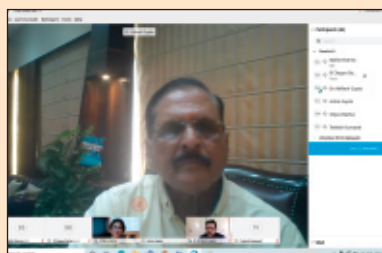

i-Waves 2020

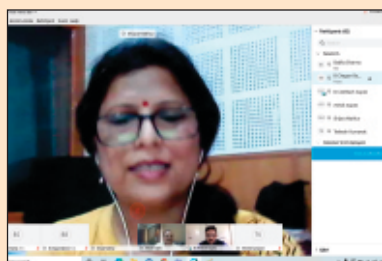

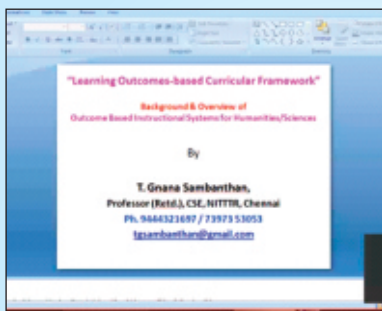
PLANTATION INITIATIVE

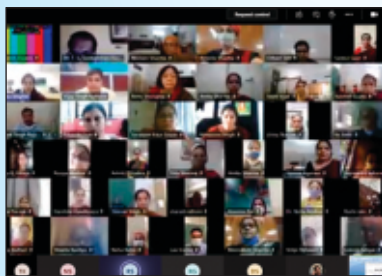


FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME
