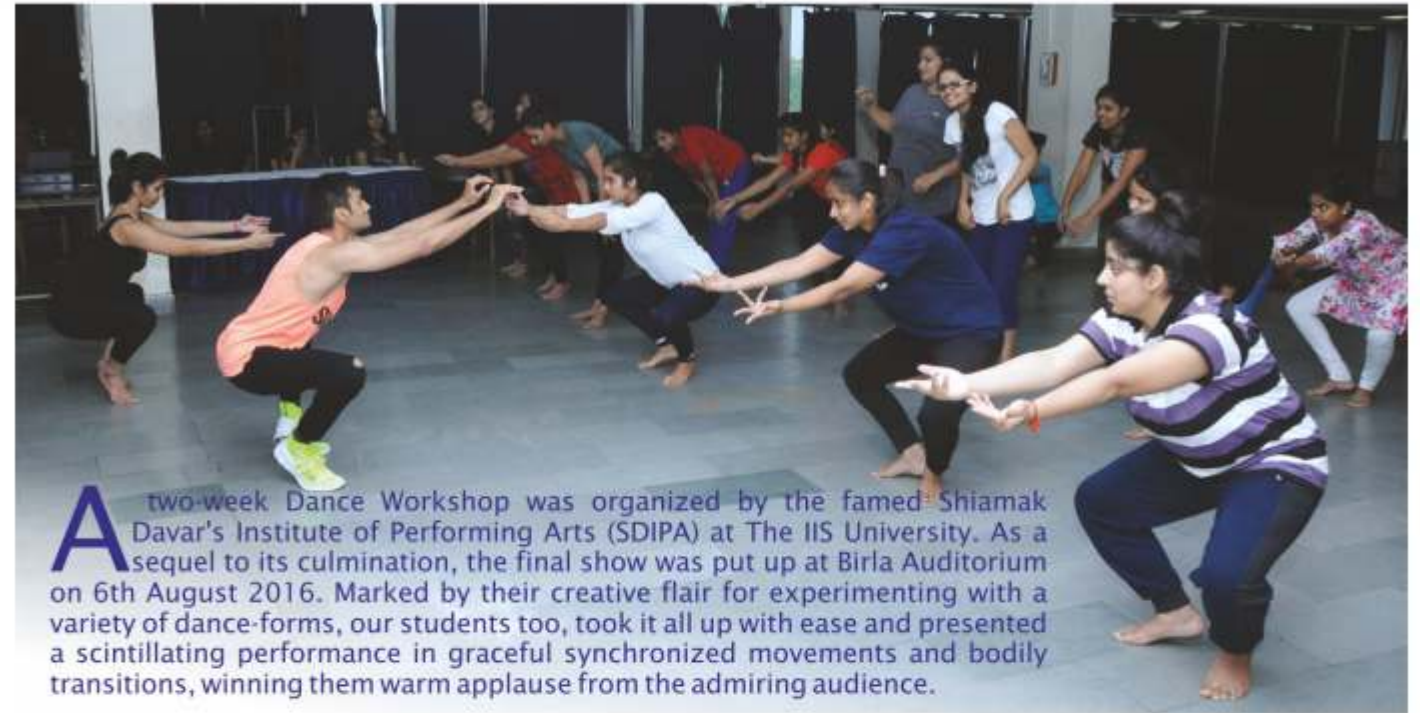


## Kirti
