

# **GUEST LECTURES-DEPT. OF CS & IT**

The Department began the new academic year with a series of guest lectures. The first one was held on 9 July 2018 for the new students by Prof. Paresh V. Virparia, Director and Professor, Dept of Computer Science, Sardar Patel University. The session was about **Internet of Things (IoT)**, and started with briefing the students on the benefit and evolution of IoT and its future possibilities. It was an interactive and knowledgeable session that was well received by the students.



The following day, on 10 July 2018, another guest lecture was organised on **Cyber Security** by Mr. Vipin Khandelwal. The session covered the meaning, importance, and scope of cyber security, and also provided the educational possibilities of the same. It was an interactive and eye-opening session.



The one on 21 July 2018 took place for the students pursuing BCA. The objective of the guest lecture was to prepare the students regarding future decisions like further studies, preparing for interviews and entrance exams etc. The guest lecture was an **Alumnae Interaction** wherein, Ms. Aditi Saraswat, an alumna of IIS University from Batch 2014, shared her knowledge. An interactive Q&A followed this talk, which the students greatly enjoyed and benefitted from.



Yet another one was held on 21 July 2018, on the topic **Agile in IT & Life**, lead by Mr. Satish Malhotra, a technical consultant and senior project manager in the USA based company, Advanced Technology Consulting Services (ATCS). Mr. Satish is certified agile and scrum professional and Microsoft certified trainer as well. He guided the students on how to use the tool and the advantages of using it in our daily life and answered questions after the session, which proved to be informative and fun for the students.

# **GUEST LECTURE-DEPT. OF ENGLISH**

A Guest Lecture on the topic **Dharmic Ecology and Mother Earth** was organized by the Department of English on 23 July 2018. The speaker on the occassion was Dr. Pankaj Jain, Associate Professor, Department of Philosophy and Religion, University of North Texas, USA. Dr. Jain spoke with great fervour about the importance of knowing one's culture and named several great ecological movements lead by religious and spiritual leaders in India, focussing on the need to understand our long-standing position on 'dharma' for ecology in literature and religion.
